

SnipWell Spay/Neuter & Wellness Clinic

Feral/Community Cat Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) Program Information (2024)

1. Check-in time is **8:00am**. If you arrive after 8:30am, a \$25 late fee will be applied to your account. We do not accept surgery patients after 9:00am. **Scheduled appointments only.**
2. Community cats **must** arrive in a **humane cat trap**- 1 cat per trap (**not** a carrier). Please cover the trap (an old sheet works great for this) to help the cat feel safe and secure. SnipWell reserves the right to decline surgery intake for any community cat in a carrier. Cats that arrive in a carrier do **NOT** qualify for subsidized pricing and will be billed at regular pricing.
3. We request that you do not line the bottom of the trap prior to surgery, as this makes administering medication through the trap difficult. Do not place glass/plastic food/water bowls in the trap.
4. Please do not place blankets in the trap. This can cause overheating (increasing the risk of complications during surgery recovery) and can make administering medications through the trap difficult. **SnipWell is not responsible for lost items such as pet food/water bowls, blankets, or other personal items that were left in the cat trap.**
5. Pick-up time is **3:30pm, the same day as surgery**. If you arrive after 4:00pm, a \$25 late fee will be applied to your account.
6. For concerns about sick or injured community cats, please call ahead so we can schedule accordingly.

The following items are included in our TNR package (**\$40.00**):

- ✓ Spay/Neuter surgery
- ✓ Ear Tip (required)
- ✓ Rabies vaccination
- ✓ FVRCP (feline distemper) vaccination
- ✓ Meloxicam Injection (24-hour pain control injection)
- ✓ Warm fluids (to combat dehydration and maintain warm body temperature)

- ★ If fleas are present, a Capstar (fast-acting flea treatment) will be administered at an additional charge of \$5.00.
