



Feral/Community Cat Package - \$30:

The following items are INCLUDED in our Feral/Community Cat Package -

- Surgery - Spay or Neuter
- Ear Tip
- Rabies Vaccine
- FVRCP Vaccine
- Meloxicam Injection (24 hour anti-inflammatory injection for pain)
- Buprenex Sustained Release Injection (opioid that provides additional pain control for up to 3 days)
- Warm Subcutaneous Fluids - to help combat dehydration and maintain warm body temperature

These additional items are offered at a reduced price for Feral/Community Cats -

- Microchip - \$7
- FELV/FIV Test - \$20
- FELV Vaccine (*Good for 2 years after initial series) - \$20

Additional Information about surgery -

1. **Check in time is 730 AM. Scheduled appointments only - no walk ins at this time.**
2. Feral Cats need to arrive in a trap with only 1 cat per trap. Please make sure to cover the trap (an old sheet works great for this!) to help the patient feel safe and secure. We also request that you not line the trap with newspaper prior to surgery as this makes administering medication through the trap difficult.
3. **Pick up times are as follows:**
 - Feral Cats - 730 - 8 AM the morning after surgery, EXCEPT *Fridays (*330 PM the same day)
4. For concerns about sick or injured feral/community cats, please call ahead so we can schedule accordingly.
5. **SnipWell's current surgery days are: by appointment only!**
